



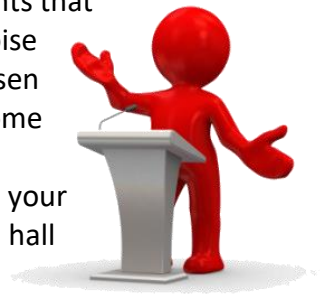

- Using Flaming Text
- Putting all the things we have learned together



Directions

1. Document
 - a. Save this as "HHH Limited Time Only"
 - b. DO NOT turn on No Spacing! Leave it on "Normal" on this project!
 - c. .5" on the top and bottom. .75" on the left and right.
 - d. Turn on center, and go to direction number 11 and then come back to follow the next direction.
 - e. Jump down to direction 5, follow that set of directions, and then come back to the next direction.
 - f. Under the graphic you just included, type in the text you see on the paper in Freestyle Script size 22 and change the color to a darker color of your choice.
 - g. Turn on the Gridlines under VIEW – SHOW – GRIDLINES when you are moving objects around. Turn the gridlines off so they are not distracting while you are typing or doing other procedures.



2. Background & Border & Watermark

- a. **Background:** Go to DESIGN – PAGE BACKGROUND – PAGE COLOR and once the dialog box opens go to FILL EFFECTS and then find the one called PARCHMENT. It should be the third one on the bottom row.
- b. **Border:** Go to DESIGN – PAGE BACKGROUND – PAGE BORDER and once the dialog box opens go to the ART list. The star we are looking for is right under a heart shape with a lightning bolt attached to it. We want it to be size 20.
- c. **Watermark:** Go to DESIGN – PAGE BACKGROUND – WATER MARK and go to CUSTOM WATERMARK and PICTURE WATERMARK. Then do a search for “Special Offer”. Click on the funnel icon and choose “Transparent” and find one that looks similar to the one I used on the project.

3. Menu Item text boxes.

- a. INSERT – ILLUSTRATIONS – SHAPES - BASIC SHAPES choose the small box with the letter A in it.
- b. Click on the border of the text box and on the new ribbon, go to ARRANGE – WRAP TEXT – TIGHT. Move it out of the way and follow the rest of the directions.
- c. FORMAT – SIZE: Height is 2.8” and the width is 3.3”
- d. FORMAT – SHAPE STYLES – SHAPE OUTLINE: Weight is 1½. Dash style is the 7th one in the list. Elk is RGB (220,20,60), Buffalo is RGB (0,0,128).
- e. FORMAT – SHAPE STYLES – SHAPE FILL – TEXTURE. Use the fourth one in the fourth row
- f. DO NOT turn on No Spacing on these text boxes, leave “Normal” turned on instead.
- g. **Top line of text:** Amienne size 26. Elk is RGB (220,20,60), Buffalo is RGB (0,0,128).
- h. **Two paragraphs of the menu:** Poor Richard size 12, RGB (160,82,45) and turn on Justify.
- i. **Prices:** Elephant size 12 and in black. Using wingdings, insert the symbol between the info.

4. Bottom text box:

- a. **Dimensions:** Height is 1.25” and the width is 7”
- b. **Shape Outline:** No Outline
- c. **Shape Fill:** No Fill
- d. **Style:** Turn on “No Spacing” for this text box!
- e. **Top line of text:** Rage Italic size 18 and black.
- f. **Three lines of the menu:** Poor Richard size 12 and RGB (160,82,45).
- g. **Name line:** Century size 10 and black.
- h. **Layering:** Send Backward



5. Limited Time Offer Graphic

- a. **Search Text:** “limited time offer” Turn off “Creative Commons” checkmark
- b. **Crop:** Do not crop it.
- c. **Size:** 6” wide
- d. **Wrap Text:** In Line With Text

6. Elk Burger graphic:

- a. **Search Text:** “elk burger healthy hostings” Turn off “Creative Commons” checkmark
- b. **Wrap Text:** Tight
- c. **Crop:** Use the crop icon to trim off all the extra empty space if necessary
- d. **Transparency:** Double click on the photo. On the ribbon, go to the COLOR icon. Choose “Set Transparency Color” and click on the white area of the burger. You should now see the colored background instead of the white background that the picture had.
- e. **Size:** 1.75” tall

7. Buffalo Burger Graphic:

- a. **Search Text:** "buffalo burger buffalo wild wings." Turn off the "Creative Commons" checkmark.
- b. **Wrap Text:** Tight
- c. **Crop:** Use the crop icon to trim off all the extra empty space if necessary.
- d. **Transparency:** Double click on the photo. On the ribbon, go to the COLOR icon. Choose "Set Transparency Color" and click on the white area of the burger. You should now see the colored background instead of the white background that the picture had.
- e. **Size:** 1.75" tall



8. Double Arrow Graphic:

- a. **Search Text:** "double arrow." Turn off the "Creative Commons" checkmark.
- b. **Wrap Text:** Tight
- c. **Crop:** Use the crop icon to trim off all the extra empty space if necessary.
- d. **Transparency:** Double click on the photo. On the ribbon, go to the COLOR icon. Choose "Set Transparency Color" and click on the white area in the center of the arrows. You should now see the colored background instead of the white background that the picture had.
- e. **Size:** 1.75" wide

9. Strawberry Salad Graphic:

- a. **Search Text:** "strawberry salad" Turn off the "Creative Commons" checkmark. On the dialog box, you will see a funnel icon. Click on it and choose "Transparent."
- b. **Crop:** Use the crop icon to trim off all the extra empty space if necessary.
- c. **Transparency:** Double click on the photo. On the ribbon, go to the COLOR icon. Choose "Set Transparency Color" and click on the white area of the strawberry salad if necessary.
- d. **Size:** Stretch it using the corner of the picture so it fits the available space.
- e. **Wrap Text:** Tight
- f. **Layering:** Bring Forward

10. Clam Chowder Graphic:

- a. **Search Text:** "clam chowder bread bowl" Turn off the "Creative Commons" checkmark.
- b. **Crop:** Use the crop icon to trim off all the extra empty space if necessary.
- c. **Transparency:** On this one, we will leave the background surrounding the picture.
- d. **Size:** Stretch it using the corner of the picture so it fits the available space.
- e. **Wrap Text:** Tight
- f. **Layering:** Bring Forward



11. Happy Hamburger Hut fire logo:

- a. Go to www.flamingtext.com and scroll down to the bottom of the page where it is dark gray.
- b. Find the "Logo" section on the far-left side. Down a few lines you will find where it says "All." This is the one you want to click on.
- c. Scroll through the alphabetized list and find the one called "Flame" and click on it.
- d. Now click on "Edit Logo" and for the logo text, type in "Happy Hamburger Hut"
- e. On the "Logo" tab, change the "Fill" choice to "Pattern." Now, under the standard choices, find the one that looks like fire.
- f. On the "Background" tab, turn on "Transparent." Go to the "Done" screen, right click on the picture, and copy it. Now, paste it into your document.
- g. Double click in the logo and on the Wrap Text option choose "In Line With Text." Turn on center also.
- h. Crop the logo so that it does not have much empty space above and below the logo text.
