It is Friday night, and you are at the Happy Hamburger Hut with your family when the manager, Mr. Schuldt, starts walking around and talking to the customers. He gets to the table your family is sitting at and he recognizes you from school when he gave you the \$100 prize money. After talking to your parents for a minute he asks if you would come with him.

He takes you into the kitchen and shows you around. He also shows you the "cheat sheets" that the employees use to make the food when they are still learning the recipes. He tells you that the old ones are looking pretty boring and he wants to liven the place up. He offers you \$50 to design new ones for a few of the foods and if he likes the design, he will have you email him the template so he can make them for all the other foods. He gives you his business card, so you email him the template.

You quickly accept the job. He gives you worn out copies of the recipes and you go back to your family. The manager comes back with you and hands everyone a coupon for a free ice cream cone and tells everyone that he appreciates your business.

The next day you start work on the templates.

- Creating text boxes, adjusting their size, border, and background
- Moving graphics around the screen
- Layering graphics over text boxes
- Turning on gridlines to allow you to precisely align text boxes and clipart



Directions

Basic Setup

1. **Style:** No Spacing.

2. **Margins:** .5 top and bottom, .5 left and right.

3. Vertical Alignment: Leave on "Top".

- 4. **Border:** Your choice as long as it looks nice. Change the width if necessary.
- 5. **Background texture:** Use the "Pattern" tab and choose a dot system and color combination that will look good in this project.
- 6. **Watermark:** I do not care what you use as long as it has to do with food and will look good on this project. Do not use anything that has a real restaurant logo on it like McDonalds or Burger King.
- 7. Do not put any blank lines between anything on this project even though it might look like it.

Text Based Information

1. **Food Recipes:** Centered. Amienne size 72. Color is a shade of blue. Use the Text Effects and Typography icon and make it look really nice (does not have to look like mine).



Text Boxes for the Recipes

1. Larson Burger and Chicken Sandwich Boxes:

- a. Size: 3.5 inches tall by 2.5" wide.
- b. Background: Use the TEXTURE that looks like papyrus paper (very first one in the options).
- c. **Border:** The Weight is 2¼ and the Dashes choice is the 6th one down the list.
- d. Shape Effects: None on these two.

2. Elk Burger and Buffalo Burger Boxes:

- a. Size: 4.5 inches tall by 2.75" wide.
- b. **Background:** Use a COLOR, GRADIENT, or TEXTURE that will look good with the font and color.
- c. **Border:** Use the thin black border that is already chosen for you.
- d. **Shape Effects:** I would like you to use the same Shape Effects on both of these text boxes. You may use whatever options you like as long as it looks nice.

3. Text Box Locations:

- a. Go to VIEW SHOW GRIDLINES and put a checkmark in the box. You will now have gridlines on your screen.
- b. Very carefully click on the BORDER of the text boxes and move them around so the top of the text boxes are lined up with one another. If you have two squares on the left of the left hand text box you will need two squares on the right side of the right text box to make it look good.
- c. Turn of the gridlines if you find them annoying (they will not print).

Recipe Fonts and Sizes

1. Larson Burger and Chicken Sandwich Boxes:

- a. **Style:** Use "No Spacing" in both text boxes.
- b. Larson Burger and Chicken Sandwich: Ink Free size 20. Use a Glow Effect in the Text Effects and Typography icon. I do not care which one as long as the color looks good with the background of the text box. Use the same effect in BOTH text boxes.
- c. Blank line between Title and Required Items: Calibri size 9 and regular.
- d. Required Items: Ink Free size 14 and a purple color (you may use a RGB code if you'd like).
- e. Ingredients list: Tahoma size 12 and black.
- f. Blank line between Required Items and Customer Options: Calibri size 9 and regular.
- g. Customer Options: Ink Free size 14 and a red color (you may use a RGB code if you'd like).
- h. Options List: Tahoma size 12 and black.

2. Elk Burger and Buffalo Burger Boxes:

- a. **Style:** Use "No Spacing" in both text boxes.
- b. **Elk Burger and Buffalo Burger:** Ink Free size 22. Use a Glow Effect in the Text Effects and Typography icon. I do not care which one as long as the color looks good with the background of the text box. Use the same effect in BOTH text boxes.
- c. Blank line between Title and In Order: Calibri size 9 and regular.
- d. In Order: Ink Free size 16 and a purple color (you may use a RGB code if you like).
- e. Ingredients list: Tahoma size 14 and black.

Recipe Graphics

1. Onion and Pickle graphics

- a. **Search Text:** "onion clipart" and "pickle clipart" Turn off "Creative Commons" checkmark. Use the exact same clipart as the handout.
- b. Wrap Text: Tight.
- c. **Crop:** Use the crop icon to trim off all the extra empty space if necessary.
- d. **Transparency:** Double click on the photo. On the ribbon, go to the COLOR icon. Choose "Set Transparency Color" and click on the white area of the burger. You should now see the colored background instead of the white background that the picture had.
- e. Size: 1" tall.
- f. Bring Forward: Use the Bring Forward option to layer it in the text box.
- g. Location: Place it in the text box so it looks nice.

2. Elk Burger and Buffalo Burger graphics


- a. **Search Text:** "elk burger healthy hostings" and "buffalo burger buffalo wild wings" Turn off "Creative Commons" checkmark. Use the exact same hamburgers as the handout.
- b. Wrap Text: Tight.
- c. **Crop:** Use the crop icon to trim off all the extra empty space if necessary.
- d. **Transparency:** Double click on the photo. On the ribbon, go to the COLOR icon. Choose "Set Transparency Color" and click on the white area of the burger. You should now see the colored background instead of the white background that the picture had.
- e. Size: 1.25" tall.
- f. Bring Forward: Use the Bring Forward option to layer it in the text box.
- g. Location: Center it at the bottom of the text box so it looks nice.

Your Name

- 1. Create a text box and place at the bottom center of the page.
- 2. Put your first and last name and make it look nice.
- 3. Turn off the border of the text box.
- 4. Turn off the background of the text box so it is transparent.

- 1 pretzel bun bottom
- 3 pieces of lettuce
- 1 ½ lb. buffalo patty
- 1 slice of cheese
- 4 pickles (if requested)
- 1 tomato slice (if requested)
- 1 onion ring
- 2 squirts special sauce
- 1 pretzel bun top
